Information We Collect

Personal Information

We only collect personal information when you voluntarily provide it to us, such as when you:

- Contact us through a form or email
- Request services or information

This information may include your name, email address, and any other details you choose to provide.

Technical and Log Information

When you visit our website, our servers automatically record certain technical information, which may include:

- IP address
- Browser type and version
- Device type
- Referring pages
- Date and time of access
- Requested pages or resources

This information is collected for security monitoring, troubleshooting, fraud prevention, and maintaining website performance.

Use of Content Delivery Networks (CDNs)

To improve website speed, reliability, and security, CloudLocal Technologies uses third-party Content Delivery Networks (CDNs) and externally hosted libraries, including:

- jsDelivr
- CDNJS (operated by Cloudflare)
- Font Awesome
- Google Fonts

These services may process technical data such as IP addresses, browser information, and request metadata as part of delivering website content and maintaining network security. CloudLocal does not control how these third-party services handle data and encourages you to review their respective privacy policies.

Cookies

CloudLocal Technologies does not use tracking cookies for advertising or behavioral profiling.

We may use essential technical mechanisms necessary for website functionality and security. Third-party infrastructure providers may process technical data as part of delivering content.

You can control or disable cookies through your browser settings if desired.

How We Use Information

We use collected information to:

- Respond to inquiries and requests
- Provide and improve our services
- Maintain website security and performance

- Comply with legal and regulatory requirements

We do not sell, rent, or trade personal information.

Data Sharing

We do not share personal information with third parties except:

- When required by law
 - When necessary to provide requested services
 - When using infrastructure providers essential to website operation (such as hosting or CDNs)

Technical log data is retained only as long as reasonably necessary for security and operational purposes.
